

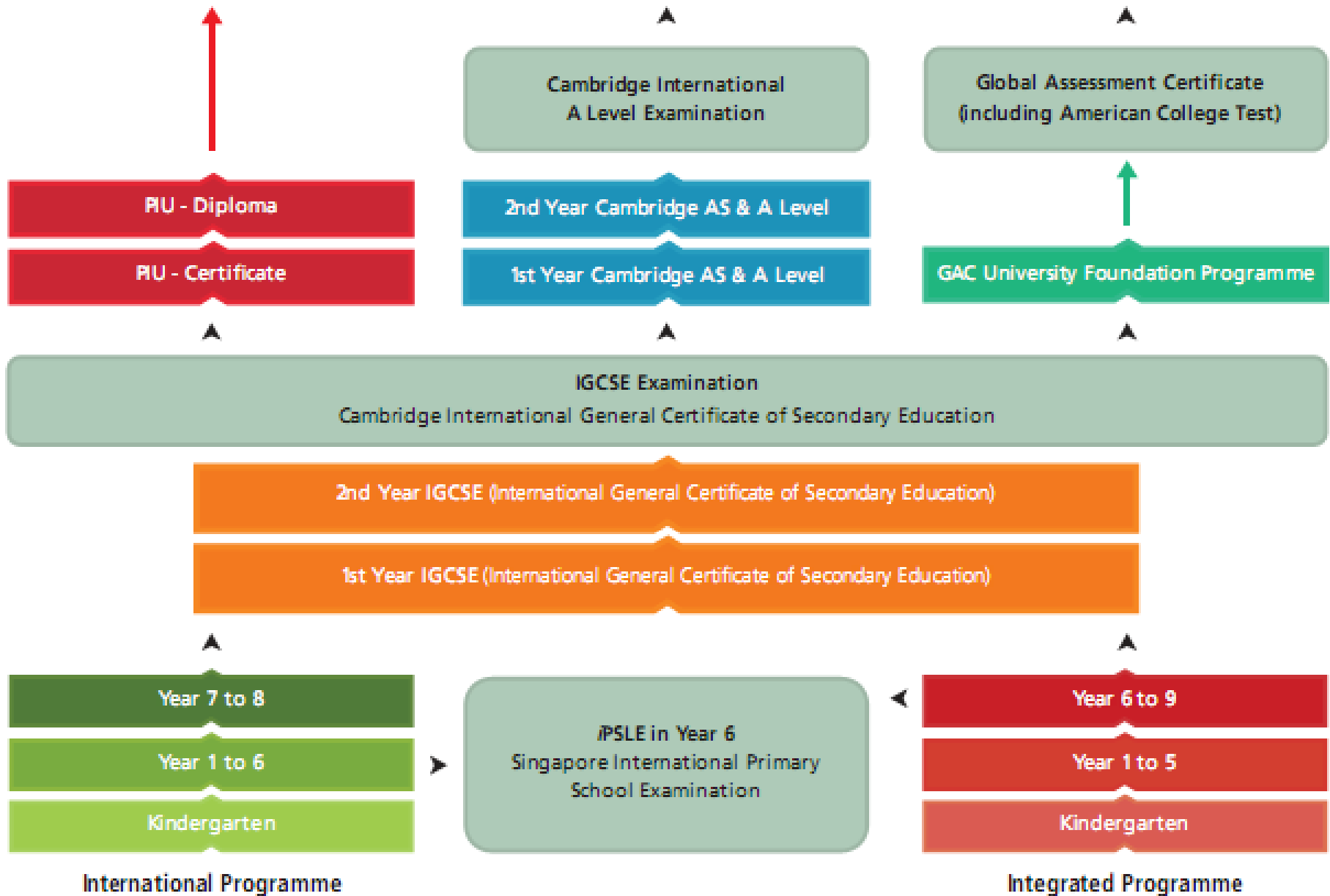

- Intensive 1 year University Preparation
- Provides a pathway into university bachelor degree programs worldwide including:

**The GAC is the only international university preparation program that includes the ACT (American College Test) test as part of its curriculum.**

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# High School Programme

## Cambridge International A/AS Levels

- Created by the University of Cambridge especially for international groups
- Internationally benchmarked (125 countries)
- Students can undertake Cambridge International AS and A level study over 2 years before applying for University entry
- Accepted worldwide by top Universities such as Cambridge, Stanford, Harvard

### AS Levels

- Half the content of A Level
- Can be completed in one year
- Qualification in its own right



# What will students study in A/AS Levels?

Subject choice is crucial as many university courses ask for specific subjects to be studied at A level.

Students will select a minimum of three (3) and maximum of five (5) subjects from Group A, B and C.
